COMMISSION COMMENTS: A group discussion was conducted regarding pending litigation about the Esplanade evictions. Information from city staff will be presented to the commission upon further notice and or information.

Commissioner Salisbury informed the group that Seton Hospital will be having county wide emergency preparedness drill on November 17, 2016. She was seeking volunteers from Pacifica CERT to assist. Tentative times are from 0700-1200.

The meeting for September 21, 2016 was discussed and the commission decided to cancel the meeting.

STAFF COMMENTS: Captain Clements provided the following comments:

An information sheet of the Pacifica Emergency Management Strategic Plan was handed out and reviewed by the commission.

At the July 25th Emergency Management meeting a SMC “Dad’s” app was introduced. An information sheet describing the app was provided. Its goal is to provide services for fathers dealing with mental illness and drug use.

On July 26th the quarterly CERT meeting was held at the St. Peters Church and the SMCSO Search and Rescue had a brief presentation.

On August 2nd the National Night Out event was held in Colma, Daly City, and Pacifica. Various neighborhoods throughout Pacifica hosted events. This event was posted on Next Door, Twitter and Facebook social media sites.

On August 11th the Earthquake Preparedness class was held. 26 attendees were present and an upcoming class is scheduled in October.

The 72hrs pamphlet had arrived and was presented to the commission.

August 22nd -Map your Neighborhood will be presented by Capt. Spanheimer and Breck Hitz (CERT) to the various senior communities in town.

On August 25th - CERT class 16-2 will begin with a graduation date of October 8, 2016.

Fog Fest booth for September 24th, 25th is reserved (small discussion about location and availability was discussed).

The Second Annual Pacifica Police Officers Association blood drive will be held at the community center on September 7, 2016.

An information sheet about the upcoming election and guidelines for “do’s and don’t” was presented to the commission.

An updated power point of the 2016 Annual Report was reviewed by the commission and approved. This report was presented to City Council on Monday October 10th.
